## **Pointless**

(Requires 3 teams of 2/3 players each)

Welcome to Pointless, a game based on the British show with the same name.

This is Family Feud, in reverse.

Separate yourselves into three teams.

The game consists of eight rounds, each featuring a unique question.

Each question has a finite set of correct answers — for example:

"Name a season of the year."

Acceptable answers would be Spring, Summer, Autumn (or Fall), and Winter.

For the duration of the game, Chat is invited to submit their answers live at

Each round proceeds as follows:

Team A begins by guessing one VALID answer to the question.

Their score equals the number of chat members who submitted that answer.

For example, if 420 people in chat guessed "Summer" Team A scores 420 points.

Only valid answers are accepted, answers that aren't on the list are penalized the maximum score plus 50.

So, for example if they guess "Baseball" they are awarded 470 points.

Then it's Team B's turn to give an answer, scored in the same way.

Team C follows, and then the rotation continues in the same order:  $A \rightarrow B \rightarrow C \rightarrow A \rightarrow B \rightarrow C$ , until each team answered twice.

After 8 rounds, the team with the lowest score wins.

**Round 1**: Name a video game from the Top 20 games streamed on Twitch at 7 AM this morning (20 possible answers)

(Note: <u>ACTUALLY</u> named video games. "Just chatting" isn't counted)

**Round 2**: Name a woman's name mentioned in the Lou Bega's song Mambo #5 (9 possible answers)

Round 3: Name a winning Superbowl Team (23 possible answers)

(James Note: the team name when they've won, in case it comes up. The exception is the Washington team, who both old and new names are accepted and tallied together, for obvious reasons. Feel free to be as forgiving as you wish to be with this one)

**Round 4**: Name a destination (city or airport) you can directly get to, today, from Victoria International Airport (11 possible answers)

**Round 5**: Name a way to cook an egg (according to Bon Appétit's "Every Way to Cook an Egg" video) (37 possible answers)

(Note: The video features 59 methods, I've consolidated very similar ones together)

Round 6: Name a denomination of a Serbian Dinar (12 possible answers)
(Note: We're looking for numbers on coins and bills)
(After the round note: A Serbian Dinar is currently equal to 1 US cent or 1.4 Canadian cent or 0.09 Norwegian Kroners)

**Round 7**: Name a man awarded People Magazine's Sexiest Man Alive (37 possible answers) (*After the round note:* Cindy Crawford was awarded along with Richard Gere in 1993)

**Round 8**: Excluding virtual console games, name a game for the Nintendo Switch or the Nintendo Switch 2 that has "Mario" in the title (28 possible answers)
