

# DB Feud - game 2

Hello Desert Bus Central.

At the start of this run, I've surveyed the Desert Bus chat on a variety of subjects. I've compiled their answers into this game – The Desert Bus Feud!

## Rules

You are to separate into 2 teams of equal size.

In each round, a member of each team is gathered and the two are presented with a question and the number of top answers.

A player must buzz-in and give an answer. If the answer is not on the board or not the top answer, the contestant who didn't buzz in can give an answer.

The player with the topmost answer may choose to play or pass the question to the other team.

The team members must then each give an answer that fits the category. If it's on the board, the points for the answer are added to the bank. If it's not, the team gets a strike.

After three strikes, the opposing team gets the chance to give a single answer that has yet to be revealed on the board. If they get it right, they win the bank. If not, the playing team is awarded the banked points.

After 3 rounds, the team with most points gets to play the bonus round.

## **Round 2 – Double points**

**Name a country that has a desert** – top 5 answers

USA - 35 (70)

Egypt - 24 (48)

China - 8 (16)

Australia - 6 (12)

Africa - 4 (8)

## **Round 3 – Triple points**

**Name a trading card game** – top 3 answers

Magic the Gathering - 56 (168)

Pokemon TCG - 23 (69)

Yu-Gi-Oh! - 12 (36)

## **Bonus Round – Rules**

2 members of the winning team must collectively gather 200 points by answering 5 questions. 1 player leaves the room.

The remaining player gets 20 seconds to give 1 answer to each of the following questions. Points are then counted.

The player who left returns to the room and gets 25 seconds to give different answers to the same questions. Same/similar answers are buzzed out and a different answer may be given.

If the team has collectively got 200 points, they win. If not, they lose.
